2016 Meeting Schedule

All meetings (except for the Christmas Dinner) in 2016 will be held at the Williamsburg Christian Church on the second Thursday of the month, starting at 7 PM. The next meetings will be 14 January and 11 February 2016.

FAA Registration

By now you should have seen a lot of information about the requirement to register with the FAA. This applies to any Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) weighing more than 8.8 ounces. All of our airplanes are classified as UASs. If you have given AMA your email

address, you should be getting updates by email. Here is a link to information from the AMA:

The current rules are an "Interim Final Rule" which may be changed based on comments received. The AMA is requesting that you submit comments (see link above). The deadline for submitting comments is January 15th.

The AMA suggest members hold on registering with the FAA until advised by the AMA or until the FAA's legal deadline on February 19. Modelers are given a 60-day grace period for their existing model aircraft and must register by February 19, 2016. New models acquired after December 21st must be registered before they can be flown.

CVA events

The policy is that an event does not go on the calendar until someone has been identified to run the event. We will consider any event. The two criteria is that there is interest in the event and that people have volunteer to run it.



CVA Website Changes


I have been making changes to our club's website recently, hopefully for the better. I decided to highlight the changes in this month's training column:
