



This month Monkey Business features some interesting developments from a skunkworks near you.





Paul Smith's new Fora powered Perky with mini-pipe. Note the British influence as the model has right hand drive (it flies clockwise). The Perky only has about an 18" wingspan and even with a lot of tip weight they're prone to torque roll on takeoff. Paul is testing some older F2d props (pre-6mm exhaust) that have more pitch. Competition is fierce at the annual Brodak Fly-In with proto speeds (16 laps from a dead stop, 52 foot lines) around 114mph. At last year's Fly-In there were four entries that broke 100mph. The next page has the Wizard of Palm Bay, Bob Whitney, with a different approach to keep his Perky Speed King title.











Bob Whitney sent a few pictures of his Perky during the construction phase. Hopefully there will be a picture of Bob and his finished model when we meet at the Dallas contest. This is certainly not your grand dad's Perky. Molded carbon body work, radially mounted sidewinder Nelson with swing weight carb. Push the weighted lever toward fuselage when starting, weight pulls the carb wide open when there's enough airspeed. Perkys have blazing acceleration and many stutter on launch because of the large carb throat area. Any kind of stutter on launch kills your proto time. The swing carb should get the best of both worlds, quick acceleration, without a stutter, and a big venturi for maximum speed. Bob said that if he paid himself \$20 an hour the spinner assembly would cost him a couple hundred bucks.



ABBREVIATED CONTEST REPORT : DALLAS, APRIL 28 by Bill Bischoff

Friday was F2C day, and as it turns out, the only day we were able to fly because of high winds. The Biscuits and Gravy team and the Hempel/ Lee team both flew old reliable (Translation: slow and expendable) models, and completed three good races without incident. Biscuits and Gravy improved a bit on each time, with a 3:57, a 3:51, and a 3:47. Hempel and Lee were slightly faster, but experienced some unreliable initial starts to record a pair of 4:00 times. Their last race was a very close 3:48.

The real surprise was the third team, made up of Jeff Gitchell and Mike Giroir just for this contest. Although neither has much F2C experience, their performance was not to be believed. Jeff was never in the wrong place in the circle. No problems with blocking or getting behind center, it was like Jeff wasn't even there in the center. Mike had no wasted motion. He never had to move to catch an airplane, and there was no unnecessary prop flipping. Although they finished their races in no time, they were not able to record scores due to a minor technicality. I'd certainly like to see them have another go in October.








### What do Team Racers do on their day off? Fly Sport Jets of course!









When not in the Team Race circle the guys like to fly their jets. Jeff had trouble with his going into orbit, tried flying it out of the pylon but it still misbehaved (note full up). Patrick and Mike had better luck even in the stiff wind.

The Wizard, Bob Whitney, poses with Patrick Hempel at the Dallas Spring Warm up. Bob's model is the upright Nelson powered record holder while Patrick's is inverted OPS powered. The new carbon model was ready to fly but the high winds prevented an attempt.





Flipping props can be hard on your fingers (especially with F2C diesels). The simple solution is to buy a cheapie glove from Harbor Freight and wrap your flippin' fingers with Gorilla Tape. The stuff is really sticky, so make sure you won't need to remove the tape in the future. Bob Whitney uses a leather finger which he wears under a normal glove for pitting (the finger on the glove is cut away). During the madness of competition the glove can be tossed to work on the model but the leather finger protector is still in place for a quick start.


The Parra T3 is a high quality 2.5cc (.15) sized diesel. The anodized version is the Special which is hand fitted and pretty much ready to go after a few rich runs. There is also a T4 engine which is .19 sized. Diesels have never really caught on here in the USA and now that one of the fuel ingredients (ether) is nearly impossible to buy it's harder to make a case for using one instead of a glow or electric. If you look at Tower Hobbies website you'll see that Davis Diesel fuel is readily available for \$12.49 per quart for the standard brew and a little more for fuel suitable for small diesels. Tower usually has a sale with free shipping so that's the time to send in your order. Your Editor recently ordered a couple quarts for his Copeman tuned Oliver Tigre 15 (no, it's not for sale!).

So, if you really want to tinker with a diesel then why not buy something of high quality?
