June 12, 2019 at the Old Field at 7pm with 13 members present. The Treasurer reported \$791.31 in checking and \$2,009.81 in savings.

The club was informed about an upcoming float fly if anyone is interested in attending, the brochure was passed around.

Tom and Doug were present to discuss the newly formed "Talbot Flyers" club

to be located outside of Easton near the landfill. They are in the process of obtaining AMA chartering as well as confirming with the FAA that the field is located outside of the Easton Airport restricted flying area. They described this field as an 'auxiliary field' not wanting to compete with ESAC but to complement with added opportunities for flying in the area. The field would not allow Drones or jets once it is open for business. The AMA charter application requires a minimum of 5 AMA members and the group was short a few names, so several of us added our names to their list in support of their mission. They promised to update us as progress is made.

Events for the summer were discussed and the plan was for ESAC to be moved to the New Field by the end of July and hold both Jim Coll and IMAC at the new field. Lots of coordination to be done to get the big stuff moved. Members were told that volunteer labor will eventually be needed.
