












### A Meeting was called to order on . . .

May 8, 2019 at the Train Station at 7pm with 19 members present. The Treasurer reported \$1,504.67 in checking and \$2,609.70 in savings.

Event sanctions were reported on and planning details were reviewed. The club is still sitting on the fence as far as choosing which field each event will be held at. Grass growth, and structure placement is required at the new field, and we are not in total control there. The group felt that ideally, we could cut our expenses by moving ASAP.

Competing field layouts were discussed and the group decided to meet at the new field at noon on Saturday to understand the differences and vote on their preference. Field progress details were discussed. It was agreed that we move 2 pilot boxes and 2 flight stands to the new field so that members could have the minimal required to fly as the spirit moved them.

The meeting was called to a close at 7:55.
